What Is Copyright?

Copyright is a legal right that allows creators of original materials to decide what others can do with their work.

Why Do We Have Copyright?

Copyright
exists to
protect people
who create
original work.



When you violate copyright, the creator can take legal action.



You may be affecting their ability to make money from their work!

Common Copyright Violations

- Posting an image, photo, or video without permission.
- Reusing a large portion of text without permission.
- Creating "spin off" work based on an idea without permission.
